

Got my Digrapa brace today from Rick's  
The difference is amazing! The car feels so much more solid and tighter.  
I really am shocked how much affect it had.  
Install will typically take 30 min or less, 4 bolts.  
The only real trick is make sure you have an 8mm allen wrench! I had to run up and buy one since my set was missing the 8.  
you take out 4x 14mm bolts and the brace comes with 4x 8mm hex key bolts to replace them with.

Anyway, here are the pix...



Here's what ya get...



Just jack the front end up a little. I took my Feel's front spoiler off while I was installing, just to give me a little more clearance to slide under the car - it's only a couple of bolts.

if you're concerned about ground clearance- don't be. The brace is definitely not the lowest point on the undercarriage.

Well that's it, and like I said, the feel of the car is a lot better now. I really can't wait for Honda to fix my rear CV joints now, but that's another story...
